

New York Jets Recognize Trashon Dye of Passaic County Technical Institute (PCTI) as Player of the Week Fueled by Gatorade



Each week during the high school football season, the Jets and Gatorade will recognize a player of the week. The player will receive a \$1,000 donation from the Jets and Gatorade in their name to support their high school football program. This award will be announced on the Jets High School Football Hour with Mike Quick and Matt Simms fueled by Gatorade on 98.7 ESPN.

This week's recipient is Trashon Dye, senior running back and linebacker at Passaic County Technical Institute (PCTI) in Wayne, New Jersey. The PCTI Bulldogs beat Montclair 34-27 to win its second straight sectional title and advance to 12-0 this season. Dye had 28 carries for 220 yards and three touchdowns against the Mounties. This season, he's amassed over 1,800 yards on the ground and 21 touchdowns. In 12 games, he's also recorded 113 tackles, including 58 solo tackles and seven tackles for loss. After receiving offers from several D1 programs, Dye is set to begin his collegiate career at Syracuse University this Spring.
